Aleksej Brkić – Architect in Belgrade

From 12 June 2017

- Subject:** To accompany the tenth artistic wrapping of the Ringturm, designed by Serbian artist Mihael Milunović, in summer 2017, Wiener Städtische Versicherungsverein is devoting an exhibition to the architectural oeuvre of Aleksej Brkić (1922-1999), as part of the Architektur im Ringturm series. Brkić was one of the leading architects in post-war Belgrade and was instrumental in paving the way for Serbian modernism. The upcoming exhibition showcases many of his works, which are now seen as cornerstones of Serbian architecture in the second half of the 20th century. Brkić had as enduring an impact on the architecture scene as the likes of Bogdan Bogdanović and Mihajlov Mitrović, with whom Brkić was in close contact throughout his life. Works by Mihael Milunović will be on display at the Ringturm Exhibition Centre, and there is also a focus on the oeuvre of Robert Hammerstiel, who was born in the Serbian town of Vršac and was commissioned for the 2007 Ringturm covering.
